# Coming Together

Ops = good with tcpdump and strace.

**Answer!**

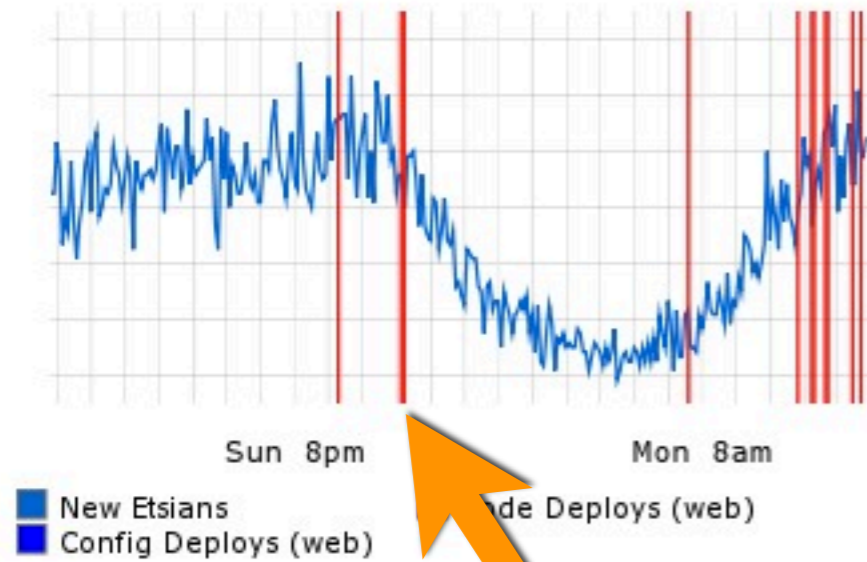
Ops can provide a platform for tracking and graphing, make it it brain-dead simple to add new metrics

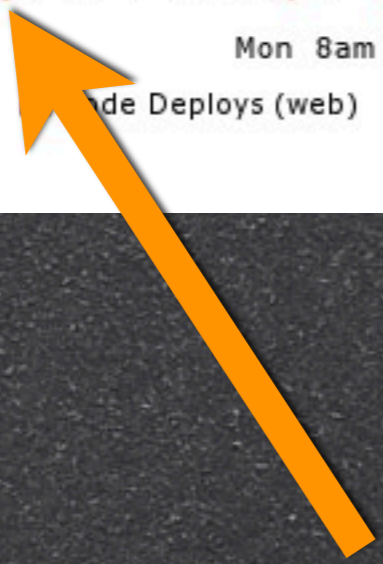
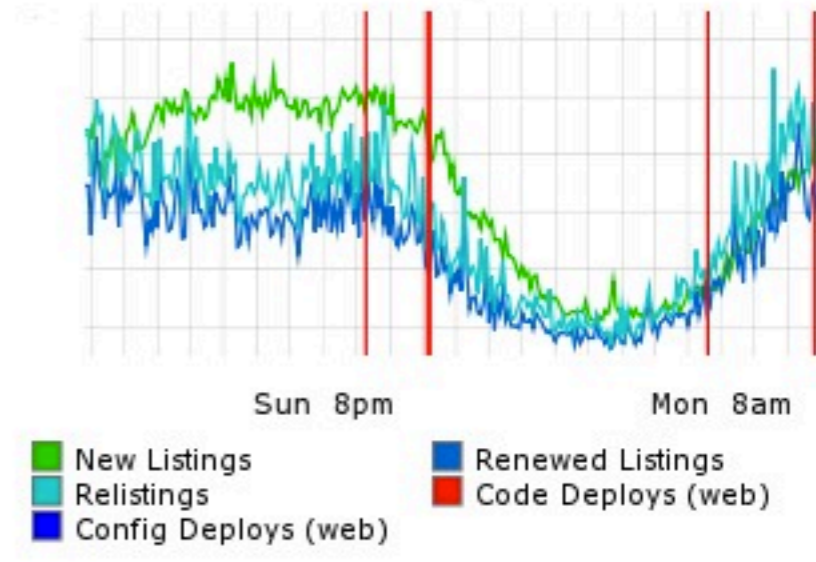

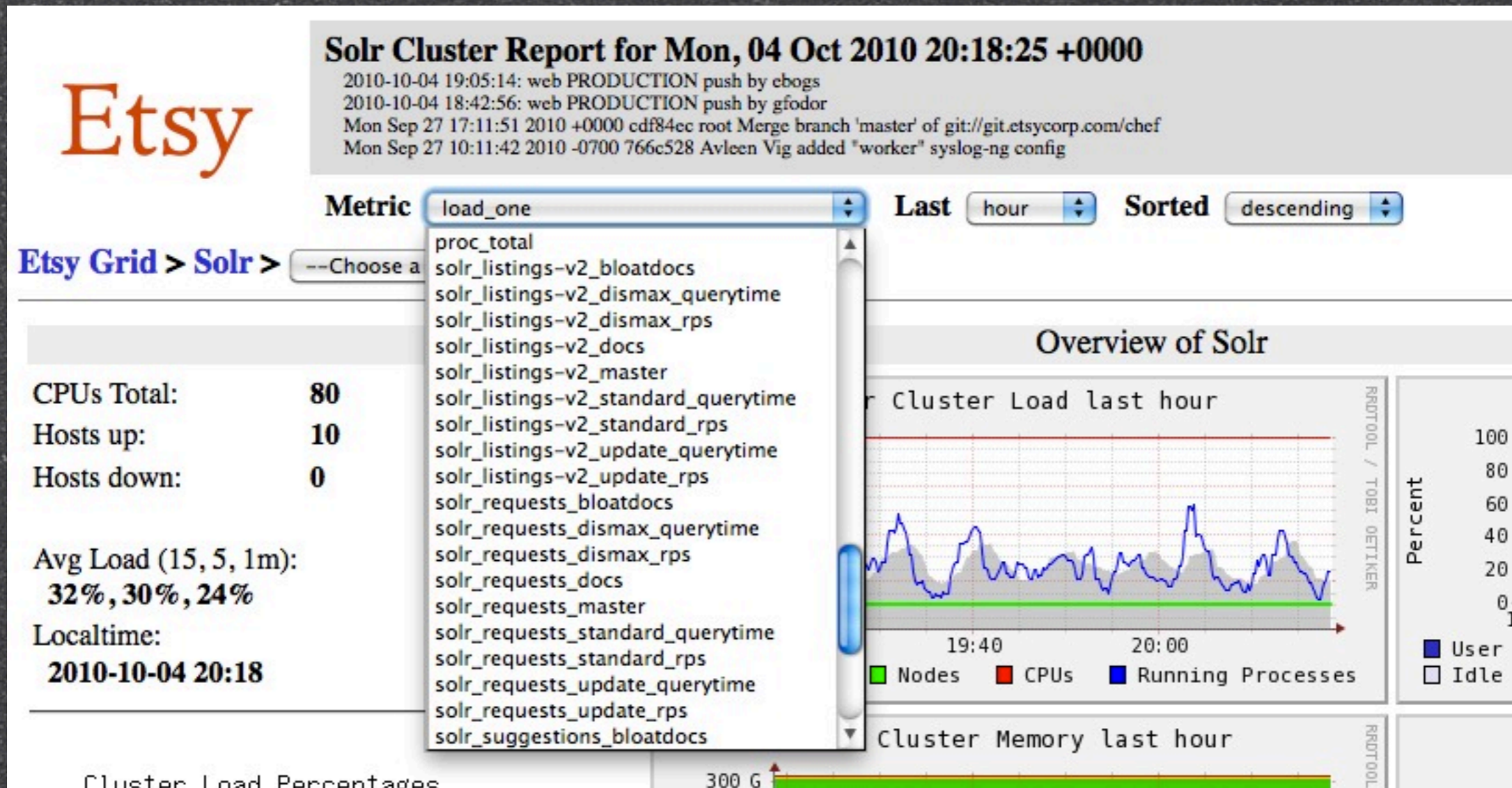

Ops need to have graceful degradation options for fault-tolerance

Answer!

Developers can instrument the code with config flags.

# Feature Flags

- Turn on/off core functionalities via config flags
- Reviewed by product, ordered by priority
- “Branching in Code” - dark/staff/percentage/etc.

# Responsibility

- Devs own their own code, so they expect 24x7 contact on it
- When things break, dev and ops both participate
- Post-Mortems have both dev and ops remediations



# Culture

- No fingerpointy-ness
- Trust in the team, lean on each other's experiences and perspectives
- New feature launch coordination (Go or NoGo)
- Designated Ops for Dev teams, early involvement

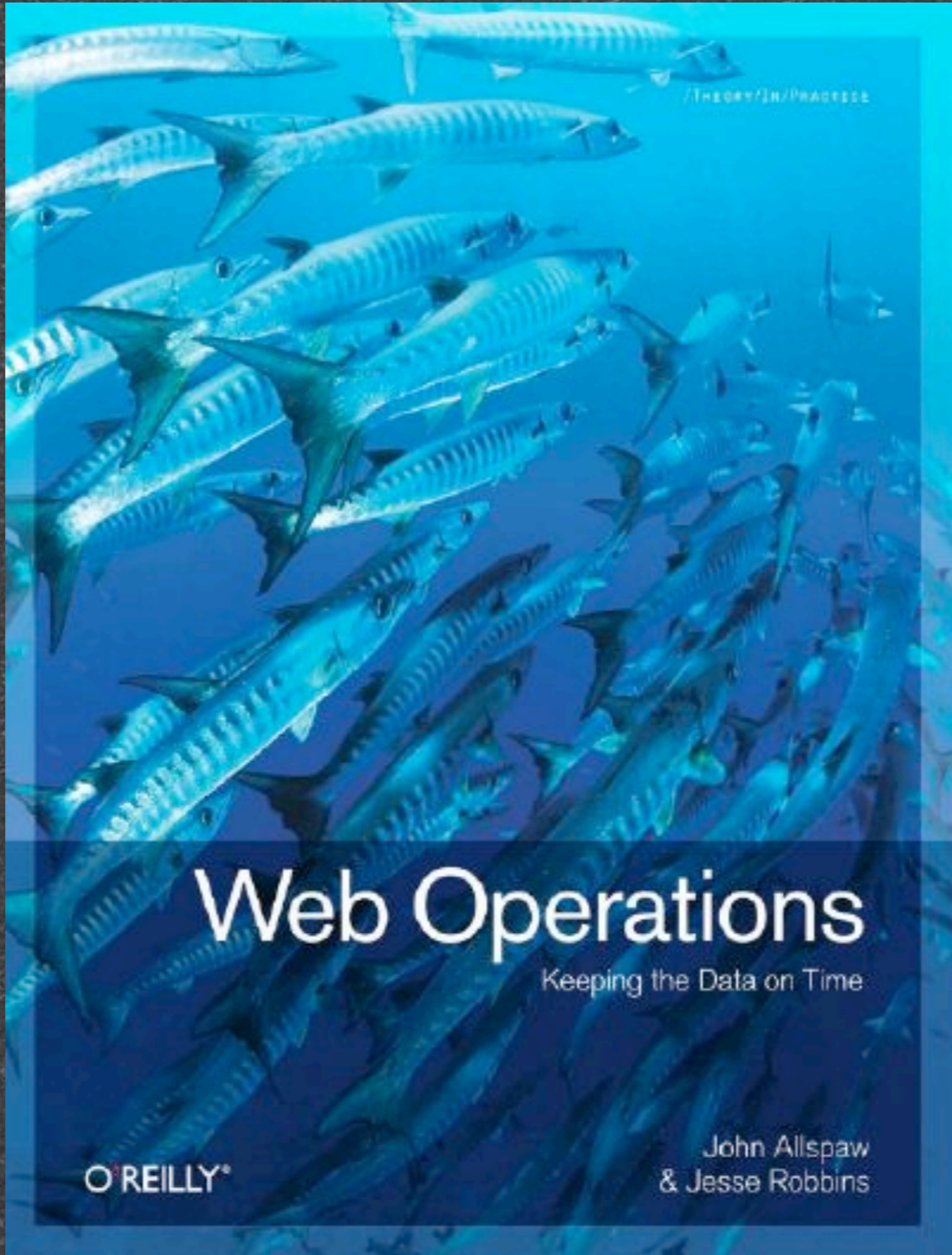

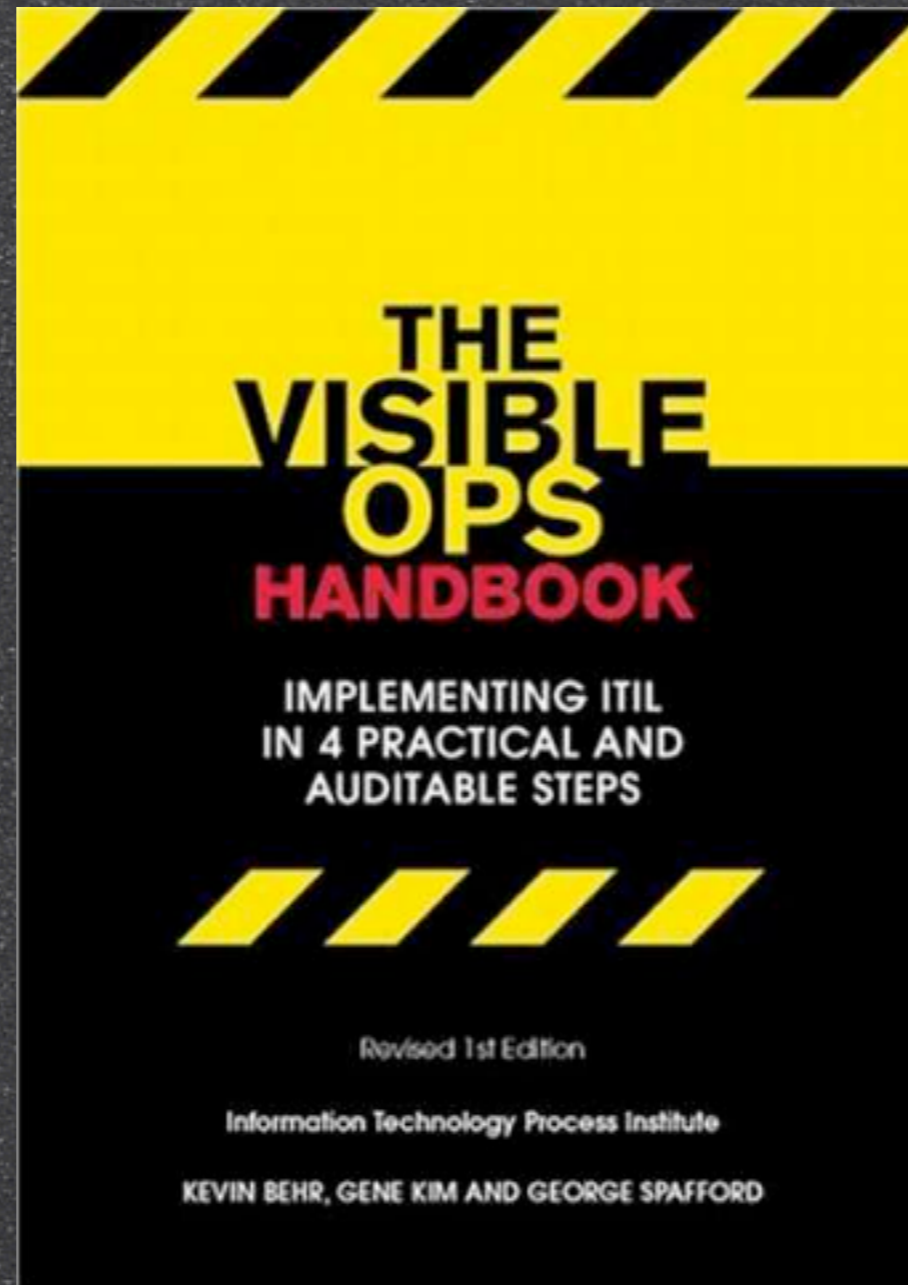
